cases (not metallic), night garments, underwears, two plain maroon T-shirts & 2 navy blue skirts or shorts. Boarders may be taken out by their parents on Saturdays after 1:00 pm. for P.4 to P.6, how ever, lower primary on Fridays after 5.30 pm.

NB. All should return on Sunday before 6.00 p.m.

ADMISSION

Admission to school is by interview. A test of the child's numeracy and English literacy skills is required in order to assess which class the child should be admitted. Whilst discussion and consultation with the parents will take place, the professional judgment of the relevant teachers & head teacher will ultimately decide the class in which the child is admitted. The head teacher's decision will be final, Interested parents can pick application forms from the Head teacher's office . Returned along with a birth certificate, 2 passport photographs, a report card of previous school and admission fee.
